Rules

Crews 3 best results over the past 12 months are combined for current ranking points. Events points drop off when run the next year.

All crews have the potential for 6 scoring events – 2 national full field events with 5,000 points to the winner (Aussies/ASRL Open), 2 national limited field events with 4,000 points to the winner (OT series/NTSE), and State series and championships with points based on strength of field.

Points from the previous season are discounted by 30% to recognise current form.

All crews knocked out in the same round get the same score e.g. a cut from 24 to 16 at Aussies, all crews get 17th equal or 1,250 points

Events are allocated points based on the strength and size of field, any restrictions on entry, and event status.

The current Rankings Leaders will be presented with Leaders Vests prior to the ASRL Open, State championships and Aussies. The end of season rankings leaders will be presented with Crew of the Year trophies and leaders vests for use until the following seasons ASRL Open.

Vests may only be worn while the crew is the rankings leader so the leading crew gets the recognition they have earned.
