Position:	Event Supervisor
Description:	Responsibility for the overall running of the event including Program and Format except for the conduct of the actual competition under the control of the Referee and event Officials.
Key Attributes:	Good management, administration, problem solving and communication skills. Willing to work as part of a team
Appointment:	Appointed by the organisation conducting the event. e.g. SLSA, ASRL, from a pre agreed list of competent people developed by SLSA and the ASRL.

Position:	Referee
Description:	Responsibility for the conduct of the competition under the Surf Sports Manual plus the management of all competition Officials.
Key Attributes:	Experienced surfboat competition manager with good people management and communication skills. Willing to work as part of a team
Appointment:	Appointed by the organisation conducting the event. e.g. SLSA, ASRL, from a pre agreed list of qualified and competent people.

Position:	Course Manager
Description:	Responsibility with the Referee in consultation with the Boat Panel for setting up, managing and adjusting the course during competition.
Key Attributes:	Experienced past or present surfboat competititor with good surf knowledge as it effects surfboat racing skills. Must be good communicator
Appointment:	Appointed by the organisation conducting the event. e.g. SLSA, ASRL, from a pre agreed list of competent people supplied by the ASRL.

Position:	Starters
Description:	Responsibility for starting races.
Key Attributes:	Experienced past or present surfboat competititor with good understanding of the effects of the break on racing surfboats.
Appointment:	Appointed by the organisation conducting the event. e.g. SLSA, ASRL, with input from the Referee. Starter or Starters for finals series is selected by the Referee after consultation with the Boat Panel based on their performance at the event

Position:	Boat Panel
Description:	Responsible for providing feedback on the race course and specific issues affecting the racing crews to the Referee and Course Manager
Key Attributes:	Good communicators with experience and knowledge of surf conditions
Appointment:	Appointed by the Referee off the back of a list of names supplies by the ASRL

Position:	Safety Committee
Description:	To monitor racing conditions and do
	everything to keep crews racing within the bounds of good decision making. Safety Committee is; Event Supervisor, Referee, Boat Panel Chair, Course Manager & SLSA Safety Officer
Key Attributes:	Must have surfboat racing knowledge and understand where risk exists
Appointment:	Appointed by the organisation conducting the event. e.g. SLSA, ASRL, from a pre agreed list of qualified and competent people.
